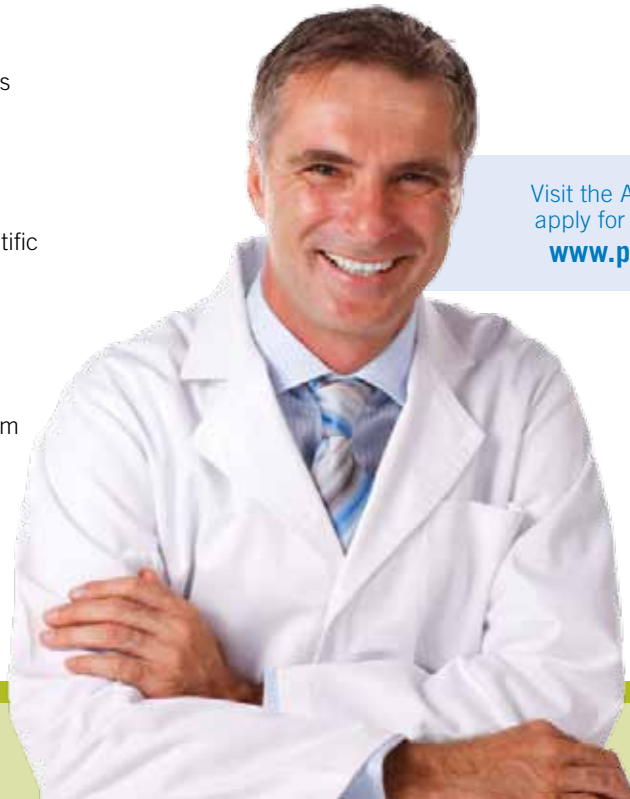
In 1928, at the annual session of the American Dental Association, 17 charter members determined that knowledge and research in this specific field of interest should be shared with others. They pooled resources to hold the first Annual Meeting of the group in Washington, DC

the following year, 1929, where the first scientific meeting was presented with essayists and clinicians discussing denture problems.

Today the APS is recognized as one of the great organizations of dentistry. General practitioners and specialists working in tandem have advanced the cause of dental health by broadcasting knowledge of prosthodontics.
