# GUIDELINES FOR DIGITAL POSTER PRESENTERS

Thank you for reading the following guidelines carefully. They will provide you with valuable information about the preparation and upload of your digital poster. Please ensure compliance with these guidelines and a timely submission.

#### **General Information**

Poster images prepared for upload should be in JPG format, landscape orientation and at least 1600 px wide.

### **Preparing Your Poster Material**

The presentation must cover the same material as the submitted abstract.

Please follow these instructions:

**Language:** As the official language of the APS meeting is English, all digital posters must be in English. If English is not your native language, we recommend that you have your poster reviewed by a native speaker in advance.

**File Name:** The name of the digital poster file should include the presenter's name. To avoid any compatibility problems, do not use special characters to name your presentation. (ex.  $\emptyset^{\text{TM}}\bar{u}$ )

**Advertising:** Advertising of products is prohibited. Please ensure that your presentation provides objective information based on scientific methods generally accepted in the medical community and is free of commercial bias.

**Patient Anonymity:** No patient names, or information allowing the identification of a patient, should appear in your presentation.

**Text:** The text should be concise and to the point, with key facts emphasized. Minimum suggested font size: 24 (20 for references).

**Colors:** Choose color combinations that make your text easy to read on a monitor and have a large contrast (dark lettering on a light background or the reverse).

**Images and Effects:** For embedded images, use .jpeg or .png file formats in a resolution of 72 or 96 dpi. Do not use animated effects, "animations" or videos. Include Graphs, Charts or Photos that support your research.

**Layout:** Keep data simple and ensure a logical order of the content.

Adhere to either the Clinical, Research or Technology Poster Format as described below.

#### **CLINICAL POSTER FORMAT** must include the following:

- a. Title, list the author(s) with asterisk (\*) of the author presenting the poster, Dental School affiliation
- b. Case Presentation

#### **RESEARCH POSTER FORMAT** must include the following:

- a. Title, list the author(s) with asterisk (\*) of the author presenting the poster, Dental School affiliation
- b. Purpose/Aim
- c. Materials & Methods
- d. Results
- e. Conclusions

#### **TECHNOLOGY POSTER FORMAT** must include the following:

- a. Title, list the author(s) with asterisk (\*) of the author presenting the poster, Dental School affiliation
- b. Previous Technology
- c. Clinical Significance
- d. Business Significance
- e. Future Considerations

## **Digital Poster Competition**

3 winners of the 3 categories will be selected to pre-record a 5-minute presentation to be included in the main event on September 25<sup>th</sup>. Those selected will need to be present during their sessions to answer any questions in the chat of the webinar/virtual session.
